- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for both the Parties.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“The petitioner, therefore, prays that your Lordships would be graciously pleased to admit this writ petition, call for the records and after hearing the parties allow the same, issue writ/writs in the nature of certiorari/mandamus and/or any other further writ/direction, quash the order dated 21.03.2018 under Annexure-1 to the extent illegally fixing Grade Pay of the petitioner at Rs.4,800/- and direct the Opposite Parties to sanction Grade Pay @ Rs.5400/- in favour of the petitioner, within a stipulated period”.

- 4.** Taking into account the nature of claim made in the Writ Petition and the prayer made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Petitioner is permitted to make a representation before Opp. Party No.1 within a period of 15(fifteen) days from today.

5. It is observed that if such a representation is filed by the Petitioner ventilating his grievances, the same shall be considered by Opp. party No. 1 in accordance with law and also taking into account the order passed under Anenxures-5 & 7. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of 3(Three) months from the date of receipt of such representation.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
