1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.
3. 3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition with the following prayer:-

“To direct the opp. parties to show cause as to why appropriate direction shall not be issued to the opp. parties to disburse the petitioner his retiral service benefits like gratuity, RACP along with pension which he is entitled to as other retired Govt. Servants of his contemporary are getting but he has been deprived of getting the same.

And if the opp. parties do not show cause of show insufficient cause issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the opp. parties disburse the petitioner his retiral service benefits like gratuity, RACP along with pension which he is entitled to as other retired Govt. servants of his contemporary are getting but he has been deprived of getting the same.”

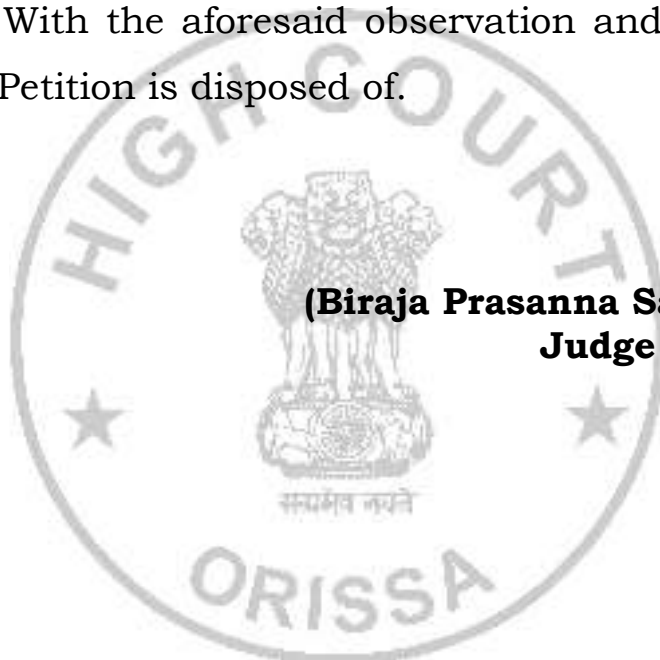
4. 4. The Petitioner has moved before Opposite Party No.4 seeking redressal of his grievances as made in

the representation under Annexure-3 to the Writ Petition.
