1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
 3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail.
 4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the Petitioners are innocent and no way connected with the offences alleged and the allegations made against them are false, frivolous and fabricated one. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the Petitioners do not have any criminal antecedents and the injuries sustained by the injured are simple in nature.
 5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, I am not inclined to grant

anticipatory bail to the Petitioners. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender before the learned J.M.F.C., Telkoi in G.R. Case No.121 of 2022 arising out of Telkoi P.S. Case No.125 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and move for bail, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate, but subject to verification of injury and criminal antecedents of similar nature against the Petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
