1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

2. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed by the petitioner for quashing of the issuance of NBW dated 1st August, 2019 directed by the learned J.M.F.C., Tigris on the grounds stated therein.

3. Perused the impugned order dated 1st August, 2019 i.e. Annexure-1.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was on bail but on the date fixed, he could not appear and no step was either taken on his behalf by the engaged counsel, for which, the court below issued NBW against him fixing on 14.08.2019 for production and as the warrant is still pending execution, appropriate order may be passed.

5. The Court does not find any wrong or error committed by the learned court below while issuing NBW on account of default of the petitioner but then having regard to the fact that he was on bail,

the Court is of the view that in the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner should be allowed to surrender and go on bail with conditions.

6. Accordingly, it is ordered.

7. In the result, the CRLMC stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender on or before 28th September, 2022 before the learned J.M.F.C., Tigiria in C.T. Case No.168 of 2010 and in the event of his surrender, the court shall release him on bail with conditions as deemed just and proper.

8. An urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
