01. 1. Heard Mr. S.K. Sahu, learned counsel on behalf of Mr. P.K. Pradhan, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. H.M. Dhal, learned Additional Government Advocate.
3. According to Mr. Sahu, the grievance of the petitioner in this case pertains to non-registration of her complaint dated 04.07.2022 under Annexure-1 as F.I.R. by the I.I.C., Choudwar Police Station, (Opposite Party No.3) though the same reveals commission of cognizable offences. He further submits that the petitioner also sent a grievance petition dated 06.07.2022 to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Cuttack (Opposite Party No.2) under Annexure-2 through Registered Post on 11.07.2022. However, till date no action has been taken on the same. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Cuttack (Opposite Party No.2) to take a decision on the grievance petition of the petitioner within a specific time period.

4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Cuttack (Opposite Party No.2) to take a decision on the grievance petition under Annexure-2 in accordance with law keeping in the mind the decision of the Supreme Court in the case of ***Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of U.P. & Others*** reported in ***AIR 2014 SC 187*** within a period of four weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order, if in the meantime, the same has not been already disposed of. The petitioner is directed to supply copies of the complaint under Annexure-1 as well as grievance petition under Annexure-2 to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Cuttack (Opposite Party No.2) while presenting a certified copy of this order. Opposite Party No.2 is directed to communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

5. The CRLMP is accordingly disposed of.

6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
