01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.280 of 2022, arising out of Jeypore Town P.S. Case No.66 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Jeypore for commission of offence punishable under Sections 147/148/323/326/341/307/149, I.P.C.
5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the principal accused has been arrested and also he has been released on bail. He further submits that on similar footing with the petitioner, another co-accused person has already been released on bail under Section 438, Cr.P.C. by this Court.

6. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioner surrenders and moves before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today in the aforesaid case, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
