01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.1101 of 2022, arising out of Jagatsinghpur P.S. Case No.471 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Jagatsinghpur for commission of offence punishable under Sections 498-A/494/34, I.P.C. read with Section 4 of the D.P. Act.
5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is the sister-in-law of the informant and she has been falsely implicated in the present case.
6. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the

petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioner surrenders and moves before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today in the aforesaid case, the petitioner shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
