3. Heard Mr. D.P. Dash, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the State-opposite party and Mr. B.K. Dash, learned counsel appearing for opposite parties no.2 & 3.
4. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.3 to declare the 2nd/final year results of the 31 students (vide list under Annexure-3) of their ITC examination of batch of 2018-20 within a stipulated period.
