- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition with the following prayer:-

“the Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to issue Rule NISI calling upon the Opposite Parties to file show cause and if the Opposite Parties failed to file show cause or filed insufficient cause on perusal of causes shown make the said Rule absolute and be further pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or order directing the opp. parties more particularly Opp. Party No.20-Collector, Balasore to consider the petitioner’s case for appointment under the Orissa Civil Service (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules, 1990.”
