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This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to give appointment to the petitioner under Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme by considering his representation under Annexure-3.
4. In course of hearing, Mr. A.K. Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to move a fresh representation highlighting his grievances before opposite party no.3 so that the same can be considered within a stipulated time.
5. Considering the limited nature of grievance of the petitioner, this Court directs the petitioner to file a fresh representation within a period of fifteen days from today

ventilating his grievances before the opposite party no.3. In the event the petitioner files such representation within the aforesaid time, the opposite party no.3 shall consider and dispose of the same in accordance with law within a period of two months thereafter.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
