01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 294/384/420/509, I.P.C.
4. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of the offence and facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Chhatrapur in G.R. Case No.528 of 2022 corresponding to Gram Ganjam P.S. Case No.90 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, the Petitioner shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of criminal antecedents of the Petitioner. In the event it is found that there is

more than one criminal antecedent of similar nature against the Petitioner, then this bail order shall stand automatically revoked.

Further, while imposing conditions for bail, learned Magistrate shall also impose the conditions whereby the Petitioner shall not threaten, terrorize, influence or harass the Informant and his family members and also the prosecution witnesses in any manner whatsoever. He shall also appear before the I.I.C. of the concerned P.S. once in every fortnight till conclusion of trial.

Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail of the Petitioner.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
