1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. 2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for State-Opposite Parties.
3. 3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-  
  

*“(i) To consider the representation under Annexure-5.*

*“(ii) To consider the past service record as per law and direct the Opp. Party No.4 for his regularization or give a chance to appear the examination.*

*“(iii) Unless the grievance of the petitioner is mitigated he shall loose his seniority and juniors will be superseded will get a chance”.*
4. 4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed representation at Annexure-5 to the Writ Petition, before the opposite party No.4 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.4 to take a

decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

**5.** Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.4 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

**6.** With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.

**7.** The Photocopy of the said order be placed in other connected matters.
