1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that prior to the date of occurrence there was village dispute between the two parties. He also submits that though at the time of occurrence several independent witnesses were present but during investigation no one has supported the allegation made by the informant.
5. Considering the nature of allegations and gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the

Petitioner surrenders before the learned J.M.F.C., Konark in G.R.Case No.570 of 2022 arising out of Gop P.S.Case No.303 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and moves for bail, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
