1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard Mr. H.K.Mohanta, learned counsel for Petitioner.
3. It is submitted that the Petitioner though was proceeded with in a Departmental Proceeding vide D.P. No.76 dated 15.09.2020 and the Petitioner has also filed his written statement of defence on 19.10.2020, but no further progress is being made to the said proceeding.
