This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. It is stated on behalf of Mr. P.K. Rath, learned counsel appearing for opposite parties that since the brief has been transferred from their office, the name of M/s P.K. Rath and associates be deleted from the cause list.
3. In view of the above submission, the name of M/s P.K. Rath and associates appearing for the opposite parties be deleted from the cause list as well as from the first page of the brief.
