04. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/ physical) mode.
2. The Petitioner having been implicated in connection with EOW Bhubaneswar P.S. Case No.10 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.4525 of 2021 pending on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar running for the alleged commission of offence under section-419/420/467/468/471/120-B of the IPC for his grant of anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioner and learned Counsel for the State.
