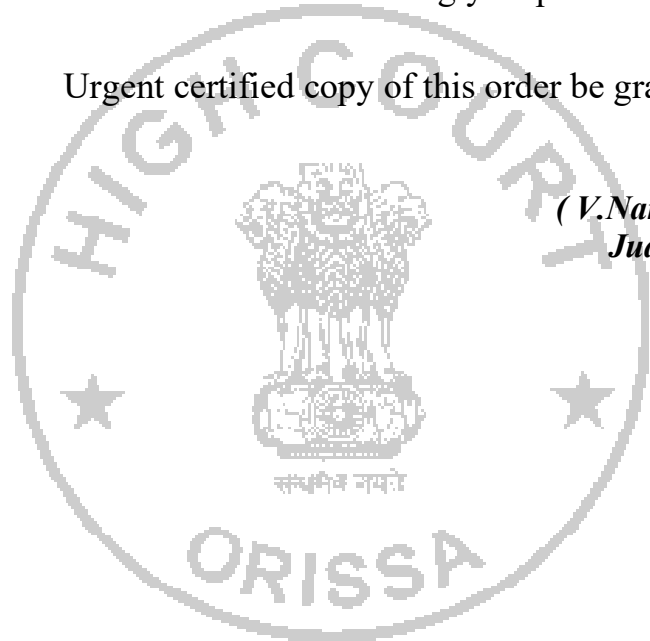

3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 1163 of 2020, pending in the file of learned S.D.J.M.(Sadar), Cuttack arising out of Purighat P.S. Case No.202 of 2020 for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Section(s) 498(A)/304(B)/302/34 of the IPC and read with Section-4 D.P.Act.
4. Taking into account the role ascribed to the petitioner and taking note of the order of this Court dtd. 17.02.2021 passed in ABLAPL No. 12372 of 2020, wherein the sister-in-law-Smt.
