2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to sanction pension and other retirement benefits and disburse the same in his favour taking into consideration the service rendered by him w.e.f. 21.08.1973 till 21.04.1998 by declaring that the petitioner is deemed to have been retired voluntarily on completion of more than 20 years of service.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be considered and disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

5. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner

vide Annexure-5 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy this order.
