01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the allegations leveled against the Petitioners are false, baseless and concocted one. He also submits that there was long standing civil dispute with regard to their street road. In the present case, investigation has been completed and charge sheet has been filed.
5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, I am not inclined to grant

anticipatory bail to the Petitioners. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender before the learned S.D.J.M., Rairakhol in G.R.Case No.390 of 2022 arising out of Rairakhol P.S.Case No.132 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and move for bail, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate, but subject to verification of injury and verification of criminal antecedent of similar nature.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
