02. **I.A. No.1602 of 2022**

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsels for the parties.
3. This I.A. has been filed seeking modification of the condition in paragraph – 5, i.e., release of the Petitioners shall be subject to verification of Criminal Antecedents of the Petitioners and further if it is found that there is more than one criminal antecedents against the Petitioners, then the bail order shall stand automatically revoked. However, learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that on the selfsame occurrence, several F.I.Rs. have been lodged against the present Petitioners.
4. Considering such submission, the condition of verification of Criminal Antecedents of the Petitioners is hereby waived, but subject

to the Petitioners furnishing cash security of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand) to the satisfaction of the learned court in seisin over the matter. The other conditions in the said order dated 14.09.2022 remain unchanged.

5. Four weeks' further time from today is extended for the Petitioners to surrender before the learned court below, vide the aforesaid order dated 14.09.2022, but subject to depositing cost of Rs.500/- (rupees five hundred) by the Petitioners in the Advocates' Welfare Fund of Orissa High Court Bar Association within 15 days from today and furnishing money receipt thereof in proof of the deposit.

6. It is made clear that, if the cost is not deposited within the time stipulated, the time extended for the petitioners to surrender shall stand revoked automatically.

7. The I.A. is disposed of accordingly.

8. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
