- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for State-Opposite Parties.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“ (i) It is, therefore, humbly prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit the writ application, call for the records, issue Rule NISI thereby calling upon the Opposite Parties to show cause as to why a writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ shall not be issued to direct the Opposite Parties to regularize the service of the Petitioner”.

- 4.** Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed representation at Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition, before the opposite party No.1 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
