1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
 3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail.
 4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the Petitioners are innocent having no criminal background. He also submits that the Petitioners and the informant belong to same village. Due to previous dispute the present F.I.R. has been lodged only to harass the Petitioners.
 5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners. However, it is directed that in the

event the Petitioners surrender before the learned S.D.J.M., Khurda in G.R.Case No.1373 of 2022 arising out of Begunia P.S.Case no.205 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and move for bail, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
