1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
 3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.
 4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the present case arises out of a scuffle between two groups of persons of the same locality. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the investigation concluded and charge sheet has been filed.
 5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner. However, it is directed that in the

event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Balangir in G.R.Case No.137 of 2022 arising out of Balangir Town P.S.Case No.45 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and moves for bail, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate, but subject to verification of criminal antecedent of similar nature against the Petitioner. Antecedents against the Petitioner be made available on the date of surrender of the Petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
