01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners, learned Additional. Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 294,323,506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
4. Considering the seriousness of the allegation, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioners surrender and moves for bail before the learned S.D.J.M., Khurda in G.R.Case No.992 of 2022 corresponding to Baghamari P.S.Case No.72 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the

facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of criminal antecedents. On the date of surrender Case Diary and antecedents against the Petitioners be made available.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
