01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 406, 420, 426, 467, 468, 471, 380, 307, 294, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the Petitioner No.2 has been arrested in the meantime and thereafter released on bail. Therefore, ABLAPL is disposed of as infructuous in respect of Petitioner No.2.
5. Considering the seriousness of the allegation, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner No.1, however it is observed that,

in the event the Petitioner No.1 surrenders and moves for bail before the learned J.M.F.C.(P), Kujang in G.R.Case No.881 of 2022 corresponding to Kujang P.S. Case No.341 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
