3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“ It is therefore prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit the writ application, issue notice to the Opp. Parties and be pleased to pass appropriate directions for issuance of the order of appointment under the RR package to save the distressed family of the petitioner in the interest of justice.
