2. Heard Mr. P. Dash, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner and learned Central Government Counsel appearing for the Union of India-Opposite Parties.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.3 to release the arrear dues from 1st February 2018 to 18th March, 2018, as well as cost of the construction as per Tender No. IIT/BBS/HOR/CAT/58/2017-18 dated 17.11.2017.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before the Opposite Party no.3 vide Annexure-6, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned Central Government Counsel has raised no objection.
