01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).

3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 341/425/323/34, I.P.C.
