This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the order of penalty dated 30.07.2019 under Annexure-16 and the proceeding dated 25.07.2015 and 18.11.2017 pending against the petitioner under Annexure-19 and Annexure-20 series respectively.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-23 at page 107 of the writ petition and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.

As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing the opposite party no.1 to take a decision on the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-23 at page-107 of the writ petition, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order by the petitioner.
