In that view of the matter, entertaining the present writ appeal against the order of the learned Single Judge is to no avail. In case out of the constitution of the new Managing Committee any dispute arises, then it will be open to the Appellant to agitate his grievance in accordance with

law notwithstanding the observations in the impugned order of the learned Single Judge.

5. The writ appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
