This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties to settle the land bearing House No.RAY-53 constructed by the petitioner over Plot No.97, Unit No.3, Kharvelnagar, Bhubaneswar and to issue certificate of Land rights in her favour under Section 3(1) of the Odisha Land Rights to Slum Dwellers Act, 2017 within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-5, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified copy of this order.
