1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 06.12.2021 in connection with Gunupur P.S. Case No. 216 of 2020 corresponding to T.R. Case No. 43 of 2020 pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Gunupur for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 20(b)(ii)(C)/29 of NDPS Act.
4. Having regard to the fact that the seized contraband is more than commercial quantity weighing 302.09 Kgs. of ganja, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail, which is therefore rejected.
5. The BLAPL is accordingly rejected.
