1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. This I.A. has been filed for modification of the order dated 28.09.2022.
4. It is submitted that though in the earlier order of rejection there is mention of antecedent of the petitioner but inadvertently, the same was not taken note and this Court directed that in the event the petitioner has any antecedent, the bail order shall stand recalled.
