1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is an accused in connection with T.R. No.41 of 2021, pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Gunupur, arising out of Chandrapur P.S. Case No.08 of 2021, for alleged commission of offences under Sections 20(b)(ii)(C)/25/29 of NDPS Act.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Gunupur, by order dated 17.08.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
5. This is the second journey of the petitioner to this Court.

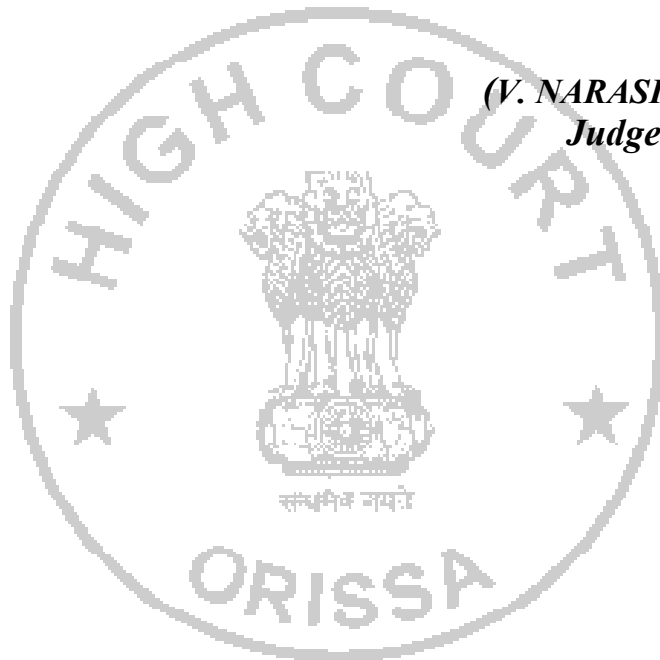
