1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
 2. This is the successive journey of the Petitioner who is in custody connection with Bhatli P.S. Case No.77 of 2018 corresponding to C.T. Case No.91/51 of 2018 on the file of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Bargarh for alleged commission of offence under Section-302/114/34 of the IPC read with Section-25/27/ 29 of the Arms Act, in filing this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for reconsideration of the prayer for grant of bail to the Petitioner in the above mentioned case.
 3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
 4. Considering the submissions made and on going through the earlier orders as well as the materials on record as placed, finding no such change in the circumstances; this Court is not inclined to reconsider the prayer for grant of bail to the
