The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to quash the order dated 20.05.2009 under Annexure-9 and more particularly the date of its effecting w.e.f. 01.04.2006 and he further seeks direction to grant the benefit of promotion in his favour as Head Pandit in Level-IV of service w.e.f. 24.04.1994 and grant all consequential financial service benefit.
