01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 341,294, 323, 307, 354, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
4. Considering the seriousness of the allegation, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioner surrenders and moves for bail before the learned S.D.J.M., Kendrapara in G.R.Case No.1689 of 2022 arising out of Patkura P.S. Case No.357 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and

circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of injury and criminal antecedents of similar nature against the Petitioner. Case Diary, Injury Report and the criminal antecedents of the Petitioner be made available on the date of surrender.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
