This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.

2. This I.A. has been filed for substitution of the petitioner by his wife on the ground that during pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner dies on 03.12.2013.

3. Prayer is allowed. The wife of the petitioner be arrayed as the petitioner. Consolidated copy of the cause title be filed within a week.

4. The I.A. stands disposed of.

5. However, on perusal of the writ petition, it appears that the petitioner had claimed the benefit of promotion. Since the petitioner has died in the meantime, by efflux of time, the relief sought for by the petitioner has become infructuous.

6. In view of the above, the writ petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
