05. 1. The matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
2. This is the successive journey of the Petitioner who is in custody in connection with Khurda P.S. Case No.332 of 2018 corresponding to S.T. Case No.76 of 2019 on the file of learned 1st Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Khurda for alleged commission of offence under Section -498-A/304-B of the IPC read with Section-4 of the D.P. Act, in filling this application under section 439, Cr.P.C. for his release on bail.
3. Upon hearing learned Counsel for the Petitioner and learned Additional Government Advocate; record being perused, it is seen that the Petitioner had last moved the Trial Court on 14.09.2020, praying for his release on bail. In view of the long lapse of more than one and half year by now; this Application stands disposed of granting liberty to the Petitioner to approach the Trial Court in case the trial has not yet been

concluded for his release on bail afresh, by citing all the developments which have taken place in the meantime for their consideration in proper perspective.

It is needless to observe that in the event such a move is made, the Trial Court would do well to consider the same on its own merit; further taking into account all such developments which have taken place in the meantime in their proper perspective without being influenced by earlier orders and dispose of the same early in accordance with law.

4. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
