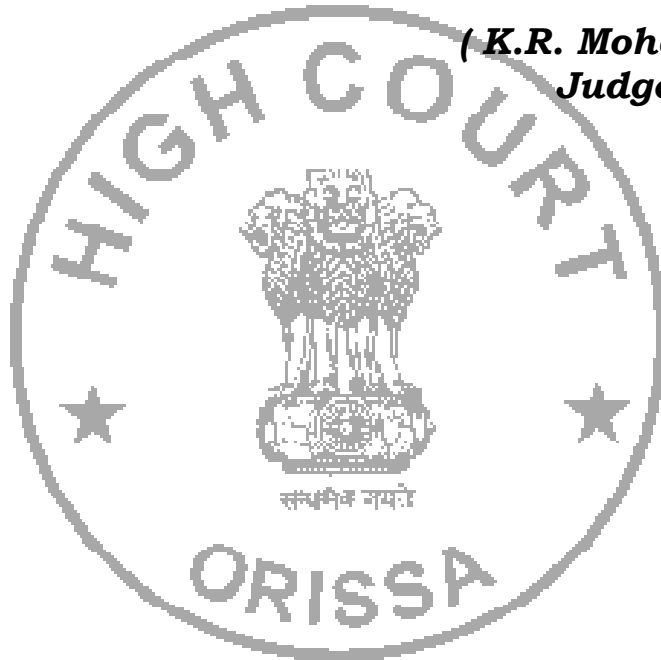

1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
 2. Heard Mr. K.A. Guru, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. A. Das, learned counsel for the opposite parties.
 3. At the outset, on oral prayer, Mr. Guru is permitted to implead the Collector, Keonjhar as opposite party No.3 to this writ petition. Office is directed to make consequential corrections in the cause title.
