2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.2 to finalise the disciplinary proceeding under Annexure-1 within a stipulated time and to regularize the pay and allowance of the petitioner in terms of ORSP Rules, 2008 forthwith.
