03. 1. This matter is taken up through video conference mode.
2. None appears for the Petitioner when the matter is called. However, looking to the prayer involved, this Court finds, the Petitioner seeks a direction to the Chairperson, Permanent Lok Adalat, Khurda to dismiss the proceeding, vide P.L.A. No.47/2021. For the opinion of this Court, once a Proceeding is initiated, the Parties involving the Proceeding have the scope to contest the Proceeding and find a logical finding.
3. In view of the above, no direction is permissible to be issued in the eye of law. The Writ Petition thus stands dismissed but however with liberty to the Petitioner asking the court undertaking such process for expeditious hearing of the matter.
