01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed by the petitioner challenging the order dated 7th March, 2022 passed by the learned Adhoc Additional Sessions Judge, (FTSC), Bhubaneswar in C.T. Case No.4677 of 2018 and T.R. Case No.2550 of 2018 arising out of Nayapalli P.S. Case No.464 of 2018 for having issued non-bailable warrant of arrest against him on the grounds stated therein.
3. Perused the copy of the FIR at Annexure-1 and the impugned order as at Annexure-2.
4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner was earlier on bail pursuant to order dated 19th November, 2019 passed by the learned court below but he failed to

turn up on the date fixed, whereafter, the order of NBWA has been issued.

5. Considering the submissions of the learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the fact that petitioner did not turn up at the time of call, learned court below took coercive action against him and hence, the impugned order under Annexure-1 cannot be said to have suffered from any legal infirmity. However, at this juncture, in the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court is also of the view that the petitioner should be directed to surrender before the court below and released on bail with conditions.

6. Accordingly, it is ordered.

7. In the result, the CRLMC stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned Adhoc Additional Sessions Judge, (FTSC), Bhubaneswar on or before 9th December, 2022 in C.T. Case No.4677 of 2018 and T.R. Case No.2550 of 2018 arising out of Nayapalli P.S. Case No.464 of 2018 and in the event he surrenders, the court below shall release him on bail with conditions keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case.
