This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the order of recovery towards penal rent issued by opposite party no.3 under Annexure-7 dated 18.11.2017 and order dated 13.01.2018 under Annexure-9 and to issue direction to the opposite parties to refund the recovered amount as on date in implementation of the order dated 18.11.2017.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-10 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.3 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-10, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified copy of this order.
