The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to treat the petitioner as contractual employee and allow her to work as Data entry Operator and take steps to regularize her services as has ben done in similar circumstanced persons working in the Department of Higher Education and Department of animal Husbandry and Fisheries.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-12 and the same may be directed to be considered and disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
