2. Heard Mr. N. Jujharsingh, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. P.P. Mohanty, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition claiming for incentive for early completion of the work and contended that to that extent has already made a representation before the Opposite Party no.3 vide Annexure-4, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration the judgment of this Court in the case of *B.
