3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“ It is therefore prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this writ application, issue notice to the Opp. Parties in Rule NISI, calling upon them to file show cause as to why the representation dt.07.09.2022 shall not disposed of and direction given to Opp. Party No.2 to execute the agreement as per work order within a stipulated period”.
