- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

“In view of the facts mentioned in para-6 of the applicant prays for the following relief, Your lordship may graciously be pleased to:

Admit the original application and considering the applicant is a minor to direct the respondents especially respondent No.5/Tahasildar, Salipur to sanction and release the arrear Salary, Family Pension, G.I.C., G.P.F./C.P.F.(N.P.S. vide Pran No.110001909868), and all other service benefits in respect to deceased Samita Sahoo within a stipulated period.

And any other order / orders and direction / directions be issued as this Hon'ble Tribunal deems fit and proper.”

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that through highlighting her grievances, the Petitioner has filed an application

at Annexure-4 to the Writ Petition before the O.P. No.5, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No.5 to take a decision on the above noted Petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.5 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
