- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

“In view of the facts stated above that the applicant prays for the following relief:-

- i. Let a Original Application be admitted, notice may be issued to the respondents and after hearing of the counsel of the parties quash the impugned order No.234 dtd 21.06.2018 and Order No.862 dt 09.03.2018 under annexure-1 & 2 and quash the Order No.411 dtd. 19.11.18 under Annexure-8 and direct to the respondent No.2 to correct the gradation list and promote the applicant to the post of Section Officer with all other consequential benefit.*

And pass such other order/orders as may be deemed fit and proper for the interest of justice.”

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the Petitioner has filed an application

at Annexure-7 to the Writ Petition before the O.P. No.2, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted Petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
