1. This matter is taken up by hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to re-fix his Grade Pay @ Rs.2800/- w.e.f. 26.08.2014 and release the differential arrear and current within a stipulated time.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-8 and the same may be directed to be considered taking into consideration Annexures-5 & 6 within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
5. As agreed by the learned counsel for the parties, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-8 and pass appropriate order in accordance
